DEVELOPMENTAL Division:

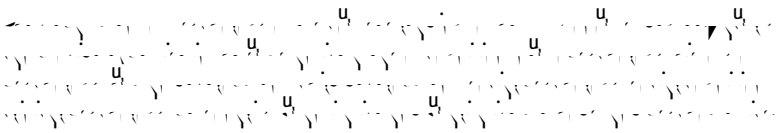
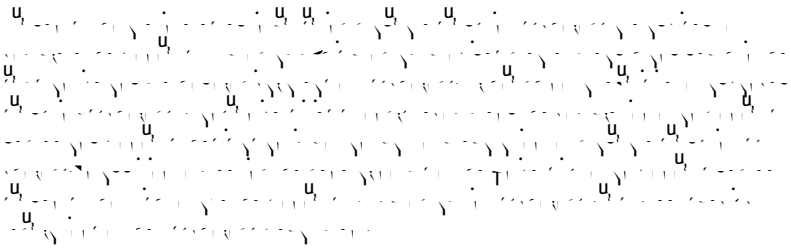

LEARNING & COGNITION Division:

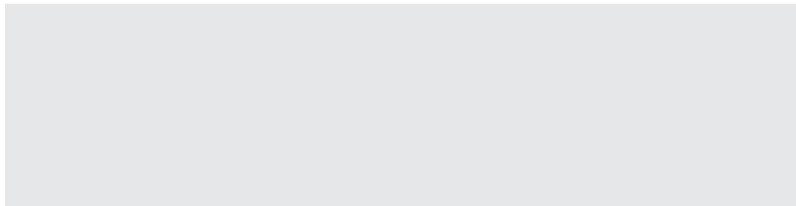
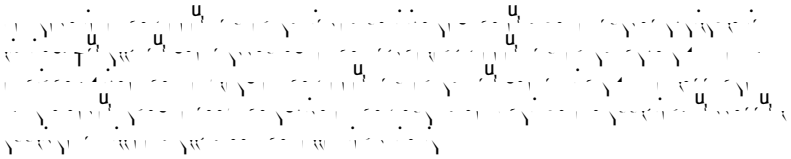
