

A. Course Regulations

At the University of St. Thomas, the primary responsibility for the academic success of students is the responsibility of the student. The student is expected to be actively engaged in the learning process and to take full advantage of the resources available. The following regulations are designed to ensure the highest quality of education and to provide a fair and equitable learning environment for all students.

Class Attendance and Class Cancellation

1. Class Attendance

Attendance is a critical component of the learning process. Students are expected to attend all classes regularly and on time. The following regulations apply to class attendance:

- Students must be present for at least 75% of the classes in a course to be eligible for a grade.
- Students who are absent for more than three classes in a semester will be considered to have withdrawn from the course.
- Students who are absent for more than five classes in a semester will be considered to have failed the course.
- Students who are absent for more than ten classes in a semester will be considered to have failed the course and will be required to retake the course.
- Students who are absent for more than fifteen classes in a semester will be considered to have failed the course and will be required to retake the course and may be subject to disciplinary action.
- Students who are absent for more than twenty classes in a semester will be considered to have failed the course and will be required to retake the course and may be subject to disciplinary action.
- Students who are absent for more than twenty-five classes in a semester will be considered to have failed the course and will be required to retake the course and may be subject to disciplinary action.
- Students who are absent for more than thirty classes in a semester will be considered to have failed the course and will be required to retake the course and may be subject to disciplinary action.
