

School of Social Work

The Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) program is a four-year, full-time program. It consists of 120 credit hours of study, including 60 hours of required courses and 60 hours of electives. The program is designed to provide students with a broad-based education in social work, with a focus on theory, research, and practice. The curriculum includes courses in social welfare, human development, social problems, and social intervention. Students also complete a practicum, which provides hands-on experience in a professional setting.

A. Admission To Bachelor of Social Work – Post-Degree

Prerequisites

1. A 120 credit hours, including a minimum GPA of 3.0, and a minimum of 60 hours of required courses. Normally, applicants must have earned a grade point average of at least 3.0 based on university course work completed after graduation (a minimum of 15 credit hours). Normally, these courses will be chosen from the Social Sciences and Humanities, and will be taken at the second-year level or higher, and must be completed prior to application. Applicants must meet all other requirements.

*An applicant with a bachelor's degree who does not meet the grade point average requirement may be considered for admission two years after graduation if the applicant has earned a grade point average of at least 3.0 based on university course work completed after graduation (a minimum of 15 credit hours). Normally, these courses will be chosen from the Social Sciences and Humanities, and will be taken at the second-year level or higher, and must be completed prior to application. Applicants must meet all other requirements.

2. A minimum of 60 hours of required courses.

Note: Applicants who do not satisfy these minimum academic requirements are not considered further in the selection process.

3. A minimum of 60 hours of required courses.

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B. Bachelor of Social Work Requirements

To earn a BSW degree, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours, including 60 hours in the major and 30 hours in the minor. The minor must consist of 15 credit hours in a field of study related to social work. Elective courses may be taken in any area of interest.

Total BSW credit hours required: 120. A minimum grade of C or better is required in all BSW courses.

Post-Degree BSW Degree Requirements

To earn a Post-Degree BSW degree, students must complete an additional 60 credit hours, including 30 hours in the major and 30 hours in the minor. The minor must consist of 15 credit hours in a field of study related to social work. Elective courses may be taken in any area of interest. Total BSW credit hours required: 180.
